Friends, the times ahead are going to be very challenging as new changes in higher education are on anvil in Haryana. Realignment of Universities, deficiency of budget, commercialization of Higher education and many other problems pertaining to teachers and higher education need perpetual awareness from our part. A meeting of HCTA Executive Committee (EC) was held on 28 May 2017 at CR Kissan College Jind to deliberate upon the critical and crucial issues of college teachers and the present state of Higher education in Haryana. The following issues were discussed in detail with a clear cut vision:

Advance/ additional increments for higher educational qualifications like PhD/ M.Phil/ M.Tech/ LLM etc, additional increments for teachers whose increments were due from February to June 2006 in the old scale and new scale after 2006, increments for M.Phil from the date of issue of notification, the issue of promotion in the grade of 6000 to 7000, 7000 to 8000 etc. & other incremental issues, comprehensive medical facility to college teachers, full pension benefit after 20 years of regular service, issue of HRA, post of Professor in the colleges, child care leave issue, issue of Semester system and the issue of dwindling examination system especially in KUK, issue of regular salary and the pending 7th UGC Pay Scales. HCTA will continue to include all these issues in its future agendas for their timely and positive resolutions and constructive suggestions of all HCTA teacher members are always welcome to us and will also be incorporated in the future agendas.

HCTA leadership is seriously efforting on all the above issues and is persistently taking up them with the University authorities, DHE & Principal Secretary Higher Education and the State Government. Friends, recently we have met the Education Minister twice in May-June 2017 to pursue the issue of

Medical Facility and the concerned file is now under consideration at the Govt. level. HCTA and GCTA had a meeting with the concerned HEC officials on 22 June 2017 on the issue of increments. HCTA once again met HEC on 29 June 2017 on the issue of HRA, increments, salary and other issues. HEC has scheduled a meeting with HCTA and GCTA on 10 July 2017 on all these and other crucial issues of college teachers. HCTA is very hopeful that positive results will soon ensue.
